This one-day tune up event will feature 8 to 10 sections and 3 loops, except for in the junior classes. No year-end points will be awarded for this fun, group scored trial. The emphasis is on fun: we want a safe event where everyone can come out and get warmed up after an exceptionally long off-season.

This is the perfect event for first time riders and people interested in trials. We encourage anyone that has never seen or entered a trials meet to consider attending as it will be a friendly and low key environment for anyone wanting to watch or compete.

- As this is private land, OHV stickers and spark arrestors are **not required**.
- Active AMA membership is **required** to participate in any MSTA event.
- You must be a current MSTA member to receive discounted entry. Please download the form from our website and bring it to the meet if you have not purchased a membership this year.
- Groups will be split up according to class and assigned sections to maintain distance. You will score each other.
